Following the sale of the majority stake, the previous principal owners will remain minority owners and in operative roles to further develop operations.

INUstyr specializes in building automation systems and offers energy efficient solutions for public and private customers in Sweden. The company focuses on complete solutions for indoor environments through system integration and coordination, particularly in commercial and specialized buildings. The corporate group's sales amount to approximately €10.5 million, with favorable profitability.

Beijer Alma is an international industrial group that focuses on component production and industrial supplies. The Group includes Lesjöfors, one of Europe's largest spring manufacturers, Habia Cable, one of Europe's largest custom-designed cables manufacturers and Beijer Tech, strongly positioned in the industrial supplies market in the Nordic region. Beijer Alma is listed on NASDAQ OMX Stockholm Mid Cap.
