The transaction, which is expected to be completed most likely in early 2022, is subject to certain closing conditions.

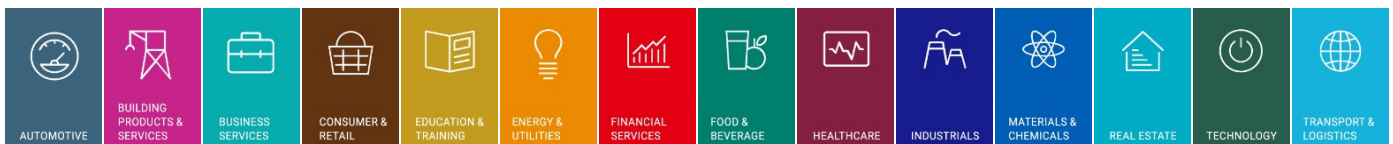
